Rectification

In the KNGF Guideline Stroke Motor a mistake was made in the description of **learning** principles (paragraph B.5).

It said: Procedural learning of movements that are normally performed automatically should focus on *the performance of the movement*, while declarative learning should focus on *the results of the action*.

Whereas it should be the other way around:

Procedural learning of movements that are normally performed automatically should focus on the results of the action, while declarative learning should focus on the performance of the movement.
